

Prof Lala Razafinjara is a Malagasy national. He studied for his Ph.D and MSc programs in Soil Science at the University of the Philippines Los Baños. Presently, he is the Director-General of FOFIFA, the National Center for Applied Research on Rural Development, and the leading research institution in the field of rural development in Madagascar. At the international/regional level, he is a Board Member of AfricaRice, a Board Member of ASARECA, a Member of the Regional Committee CROST/PRéRAD (Indian Ocean Commission) and a former Member of FARA Board. At the national level, he handled several high responsibilities in coordinating and managing scientific research in Madagascar. From 2012 until his appointment in 2008 as CEO of FOFIFA, he successively occupied the functions of Permanent Secretary of the Ministry of Scientific Research for Development, of Director-General, Scientific Research, and Director of Research of the Ministry in charge of Scientific Research. Besides his passion for research, Lala Razafinjara is Full Professor and is teaching Soil Science at the Faculty of Sciences of the University of Antananarivo. He is mentoring doctoral, masteral and engineering students. Lala Razafinjara is the Chancellor of the National Academy of Arts, Letters and Sciences of Madagascar. He was promoted to the rank of Commander of the National Order of Madagascar.
